The new National Apprenticeship Vacancy Matching Service goes live to potential Apprentices and Employers from January 2009



What is the new Vacancy Matching Service?

This is a new web-based National Apprenticeship Vacancy Matching System (VMS), that will be available from January 2009.

It can be accessed by potential apprentices (candidates) looking for Apprenticeship vacancies from the 5th January 2009 and can be accessed via the newly designed national Apprenticeship website www.apprenticeships.org.uk



It will help individuals to understand what Apprenticeships have to offer and enable them to search through live vacancies.

It will also help employers, colleges and training providers to advertise their vacancies centrally, offering a free recruitment service.

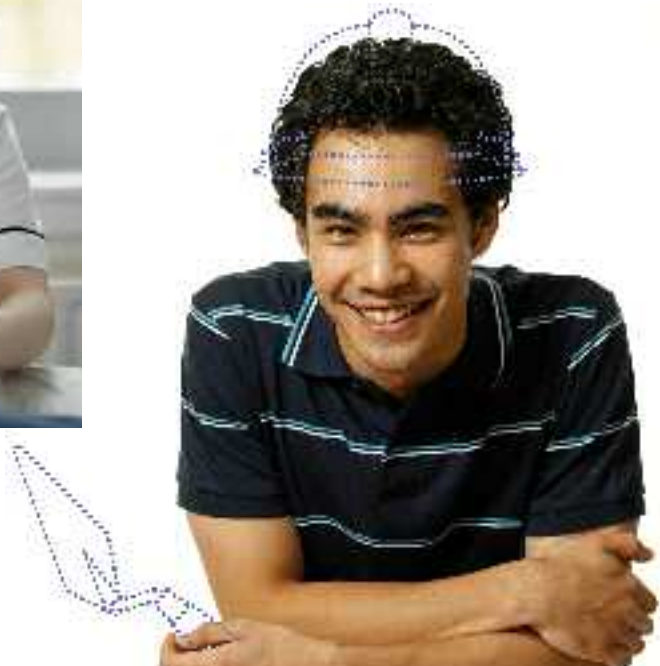


What will the new service mean to me as an employer?

- A free recruitment service to help my business
- The offer of a training provider to help me advertise my vacancy and provide the support and training for my apprentice
- The opportunity to advertise my vacancy to both young people and adults who are interested in becoming an apprentice
- An opportunity for you to promote your organisation and the training that you offer nationally, regionally and locally.

What will the new service mean to me as a potential Apprentice?

- You can search for Apprenticeship vacancies in your chosen occupational area.
- You can apply for the vacancies using the on-line application, or through a link to the employer or provider's own application process.
- Your standard application form can be used to submit an application for multiple vacancies.
- You can search the system to identify the most appropriate Apprenticeship vacancy for you
