# What's it all about?

Whatever you're interested in, there's probably an Apprenticeship for you.

## Administration and Professional

### Accounting

Apprentices will be recording and accounting for cash and credit transactions and recording payroll transactions. Apprentices could work in a variety of roles and will need to be able to work as part of a team and have good communication skills.

### Advice and Guidance

Anyone working in this field will be involved in providing information, identifying client requirements and assisting clients to decide upon a course of action. Roles exist in the Connexions Service, schools, colleges and universities, social services, benefits advice centres, financial institutions and the voluntary sector.

### Business Administration

This Apprenticeship can be applied across a wide range of industries. Apprentices will need to be able to produce reports and correspondence, and deal with staff within their organisation as well as with customers and clients.

### Information Technology and Electronic Services

Whether working for a large corporation or a small local business, apprentices will deal with customers and will need to enjoy working with other people. The Apprenticeship could lead to work as an IT consultant, project manager, software support professional or hardware engineer.

This sector is important for the growth of the UK economy in the 21st Century because it helps build and maintain the technologies that keep UK businesses running.

### Information and Library Services

This Apprenticeship is suitable for anyone wanting a career in information management or library services. Roles involve cataloguing, storage and retrieval of information in paper and electronic formats.

### Learning and Development/Direct Training and Support

Learning and training are important in practically every job so you could be doing this Apprenticeship in any number of industries, in companies large and small. Your job title and role will vary, but you could be working as a workplace trainer (delivering training courses), a mentor (supporting particular individuals), an internal verifier (checking that employees are getting the standard of training they need) or a training administrator.

### Management

Management skills are required in all organisations and in many different job roles.

A manager needs to make the most of the resources at their disposal. You need to be a natural leader and great motivator.

You will learn about motivating your staff; setting budgets and dealing with money; and creating a strong corporate identity so that people will want to work for the company.

### Payroll

Apprentices work in a variety of roles, from payroll assistant to supervisor or deputy payroll manager. You could also get the chance to take professional qualifications within the payroll sector or follow opportunities in more general financial roles or in human resources.

### Personnel (Support)

Whether working in a private company or large local authority, apprentices learn recruitment skills, about equal opportunity matters, and how to contribute to professional ethical standards in personnel work.

## Agriculture

### Agriculture, Crops and Livestock

Apprentices may be involved with animals, crops or a combination of both, either in a large business or on a small farm. Excellent problem-solving skills, manual dexterity and the ability to work with little supervision are required.

### Agriculture and Garden Machinery

Apprentices work as mechanics in farming, parklands or the leisure industry. They need to be able to solve problems, work on their own and with others and deal with internal staff and external customers.

### Amenity Horticulture

As a landscape worker, you will do physically demanding work, often on your own, and will learn to handle pesticides and equipment safely and effectively. You will also have to interpret plans accurately and deal tactfully with clients.

### Animal Care

A variety of careers are available in the field of small animal care, from animal nursing to pet store management. The roles require genuine dedication, love of animals, and specialist knowledge and experience.

### Environmental Conservation

This Apprenticeship will focus on countryside management, community environmental projects or nature reserve wardening. Apprentices need good communication skills, excellent problem-solving skills and manual dexterity.

### Equine Industry

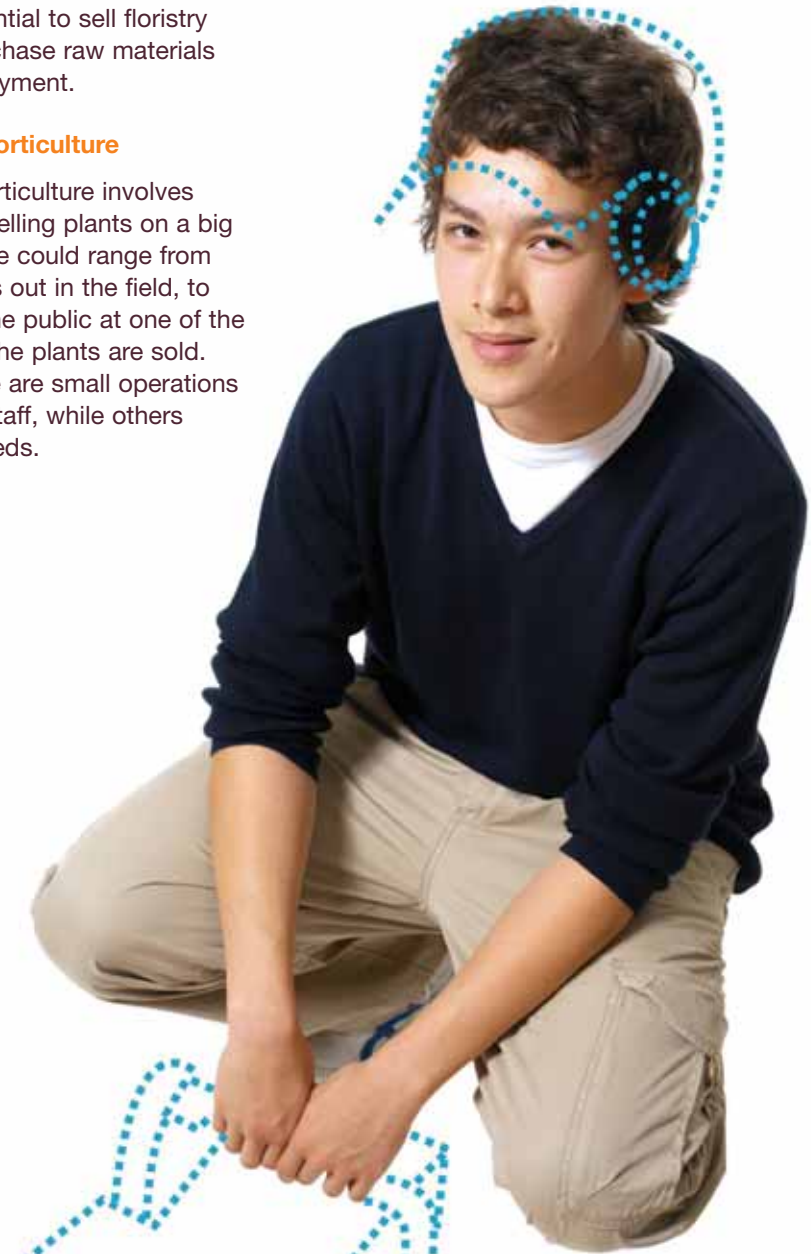
Apprentices need a strong understanding of horses and must have good communication and customer care skills, which the Apprenticeship will develop. Apprentices work in riding schools, with racehorse trainers, as an instructor or with breeders.

### Floristry

A good florist has creative flair, a sense of colour and design and a thorough knowledge of flowering plants. Retail and customer care skills are essential to sell floristry products, purchase raw materials and handle payment.

### Production Horticulture

Production horticulture involves growing and selling plants on a big scale. Your role could range from growing things out in the field, to dealing with the public at one of the shops where the plants are sold. Some of these are small operations of just a few staff, while others employ hundreds.



## Construction

### Building Services Engineers

Apprentices work to create and maintain comfortable, energy-efficient and safe environments within a building. Heating, ventilation, refrigeration, lighting and power, plumbing, drainage, fire protection and even acoustics are all the responsibility of the building services engineer.

The vast majority of businesses in this sector are micro-businesses and 'one-man-bands' and the majority of them were started by individuals who trained as apprentices in the sector.

Much of the money generated by this sector comes from areas such as planned maintenance and fast track construction, from combined heat and power to the installation of gas turbines and data cabling on cross channel ferries.

The sector is currently experiencing a mini-boom at the same time as it is experiencing a skills shortage.

### Construction (Craft) including Carpentry

Apprentices gain the craft skills and knowledge needed for construction, including masonry, steeple jacking, wood occupations and bricklaying.

Around 1.8 million are employed in the construction sector. Around 225,000 are employed in professional consultancies.

### Electrical and Electronic Servicing

Service engineers can work in specialist workshops or in customers' homes, repairing and working on a wide range of equipment. You will learn the theoretical and practical skills to enable you to install and maintain equipment. An interest and aptitude in electronics is important.

### Engineering

There is a wide range of engineering career options supported by Apprenticeships. These include manufacturing, design, aircraft engineering, instrument servicing, technical servicing, systems maintenance, and electrical and electronics servicing and production. Apprentices may do welding, pipe-fitting, mechanical fitting, plating or steel erecting. In the offshore sector, there are opportunities for maintenance careers. The industry also requires design, draughting and non-destructive testing apprentices.

### Mechanical Engineering Services: Plumbing

This is a very varied profession for which you will need to master the skills of cutting, bending and jointing pipework of all types, including copper, plastic, steel and iron. Training will be given on both gas appliances and oil-fuelled systems.



## Customer Service, Retailing and Wholesaling

### Contact Centres

Apprentices could work in sales, information retrieval or account management and will need highly developed customer service skills.

This sector is important for the growth of the UK economy in the 21st Century because it helps build and maintain the technologies that keep UK businesses running.

Large-scale recruitment and increased skills are essential if the UK is to continue being a big player in the contact centre market.

### Customer Service

A wide variety of skills are needed for the Customer Service Apprenticeship, including identifying customers and what they value, patience, commitment to work, not being judgemental and an excellent telephone manner.

### Retailing

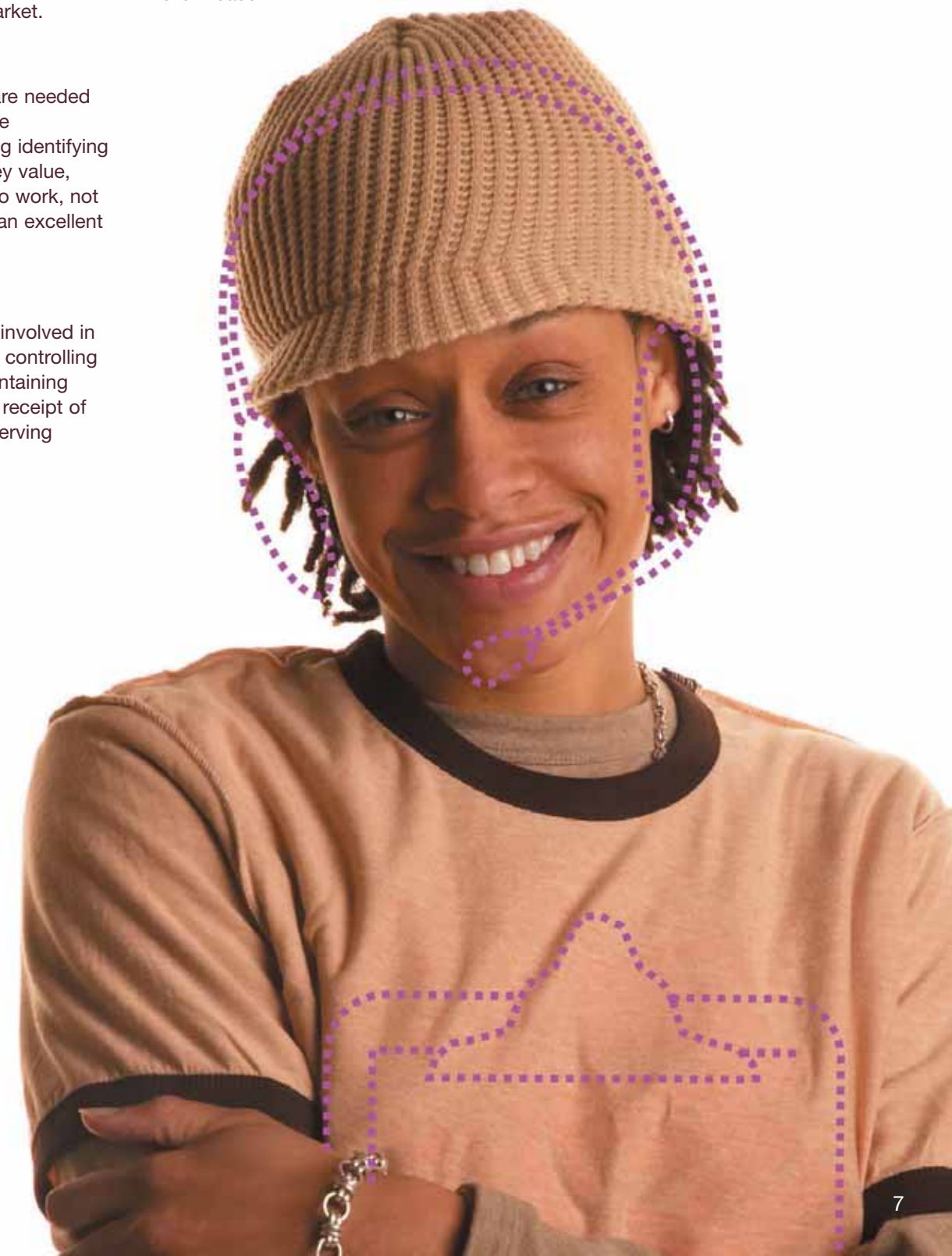
An apprentice could be involved in giving advice on goods, controlling cash, checking and maintaining displays, organising the receipt of goods and, of course, serving customers.

### Sales and Telesales

Sales people work in a variety of settings - car dealerships, call centres or even working door-to-door - to promote products and services, research customer trends and demands, agree prices and get customers to sign contracts. You'll need to be able to persuade customers that they need a particular product or service so that means building relationships with customers in order to build a loyal client base.

### Wholesale, Distribution, Warehousing and Storage

Anyone working in this field will be involved in care and control of stock, dispatching goods and materials, and assembling bulk orders for distribution.



## Engineering

### Electrical and Electronic Servicing

Service engineers can work in specialist workshops or in customers' homes, repairing and working on a wide range of equipment. You will learn the theoretical and practical skills to enable you to install and maintain equipment. An interest and aptitude in electronics is important.

### Electricity Industry

Apprenticeships are available in power generation and electricity distribution and supply. The Apprenticeship will teach you the skills needed for the real world and will open the door to many further training opportunities.

The government, producers, suppliers and customers in the electricity industry now demand greater efficiency in the use of natural resources. This includes both fuel for energy or water for supply.

This sector covers all types of companies involved in the creation and delivery of electricity, fuel for heat, water, the removal of waste water and the waste management sector.

### Electrotechnical

Electricians are involved in the design, installation and maintenance of electrical systems and equipment in industrial, commercial and domestic locations. There is a constant demand for electricians and the industry offers excellent career prospects.

### Engineering

An engineering apprenticeship can lead you to many possibilities. Engineers work in a vast range of environments, you will find them with employers specialising in marine, electronics, electrical power generation, car and other vehicle manufacture, aerospace, even in hospitals maintaining medical equipment or looking after the

processing equipment where food and drink is manufactured and packaged.

Some engineering apprenticeships involve a wide range of craft skills such as working as mechanical fitters, fabricators and welders, maintenance electricians, mould and toolmakers. Other apprenticeships offer the opportunity to undertake technician level training for roles such as test technicians, draftspeople and design technicians, estimators, inspectors, manufacturing planning engineers and maintenance technicians. There are also opportunities to progress to higher levels of skills and qualifications.

### Gas Industry

Careers in the gas industry could focus on gas services installation, maintenance or engineering. As an apprentice, you will need to be able to solve problems and work well on your own and with others.

The government, producers, suppliers and customers in the electricity industry now demand greater efficiency in the use of natural resources. This includes both fuel for energy or water for supply.

### Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration

Apprentices need to be able to work accurately, effectively, on their own initiative and as part of a team. Work may take place at domestic or industrial premises, and apprentices may work on-site or at customers' premises.

### Land-based Service Engineering

Land based engineers are responsible for applying their knowledge of science and technology to agricultural problems.

Broadly speaking, land-based service engineers will work in agricultural, forestry or horticulture (horticulture covers flowers, fruit and vegetables) to design, test, maintain and improve the equipment used in these industries. This could involve anything from driving a dump truck through a field to test the durability of its tyres, to planning how to build a super-efficient greenhouse.

### Manufacturing

With this Apprenticeship, you will develop skills in a range of activities, including cutting, shaping, building assemblies and processing products. Skills involved could include forming/moulding, finishing and joining, and can relate to products as diverse as footwear and cosmetics.

## Finance, Insurance and Real Estate

### Insurance

Apprentices could be involved in dealing with claims, setting up new policies and servicing existing ones. Apprentices may handle large corporate clients across a wide range of industries or could deal with private insurance policy holders.

### International Trade Services

Apprentices are given a thorough grounding in the movement of goods, methods of distribution and trading and payment terms. Job roles in this sector include freight forwarding clerk, export administration officer and import clerk.

### Property Services

As a member of staff in an estate agency or residential property letting and management agency, you will deal with enquiries by prospective buyers or tenants, provide a professional image and secure appointments. You will need to work alone or as part of a team.

### Providing Financial Services

Apprentices may specialise in customer service, administration, or providing financial advice. To work in financial services, you need to have good numeracy, communication and information technology skills.

There are a wide range of businesses in this sector, including Independent Financial Advisers working by themselves to global companies with lots of employees.

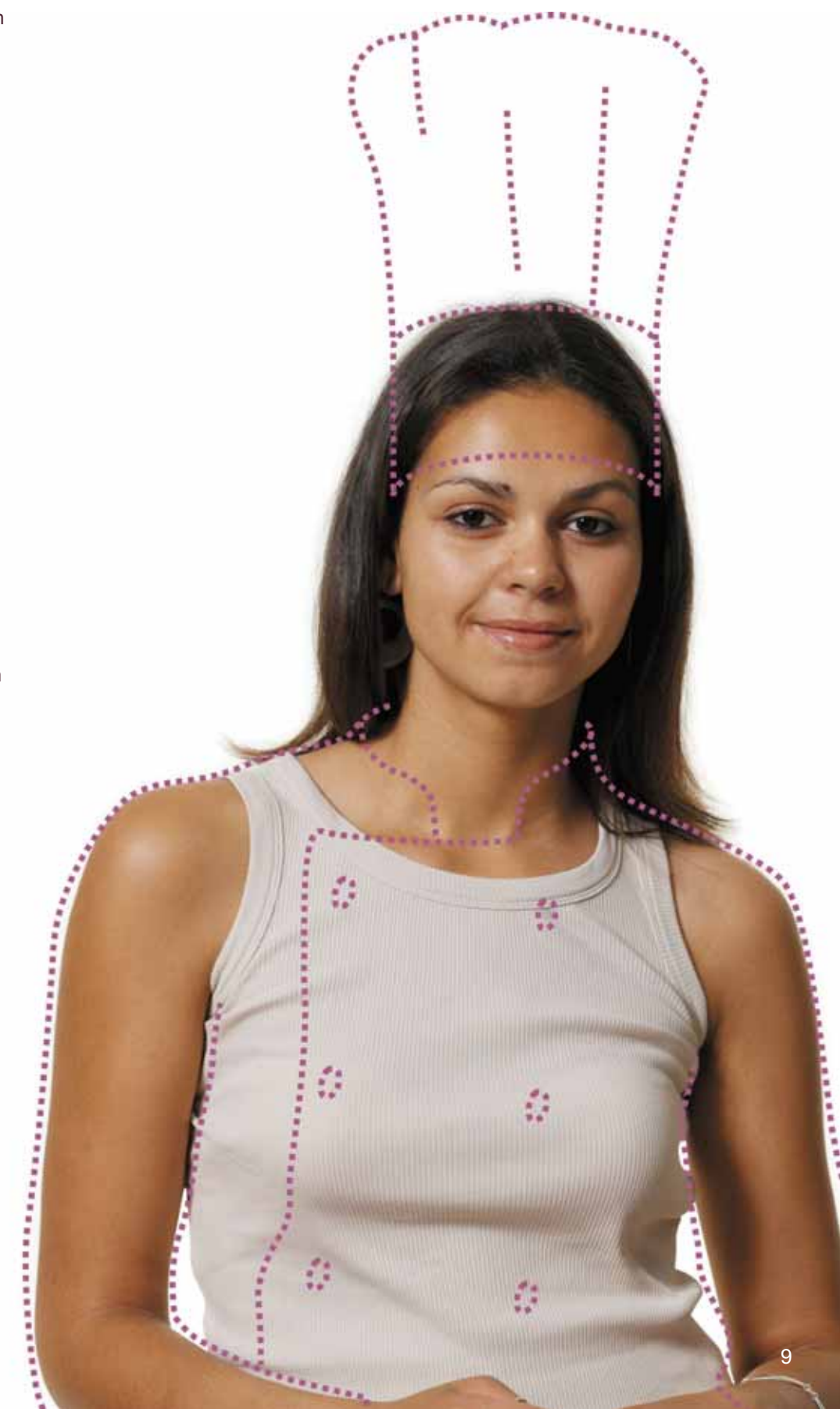
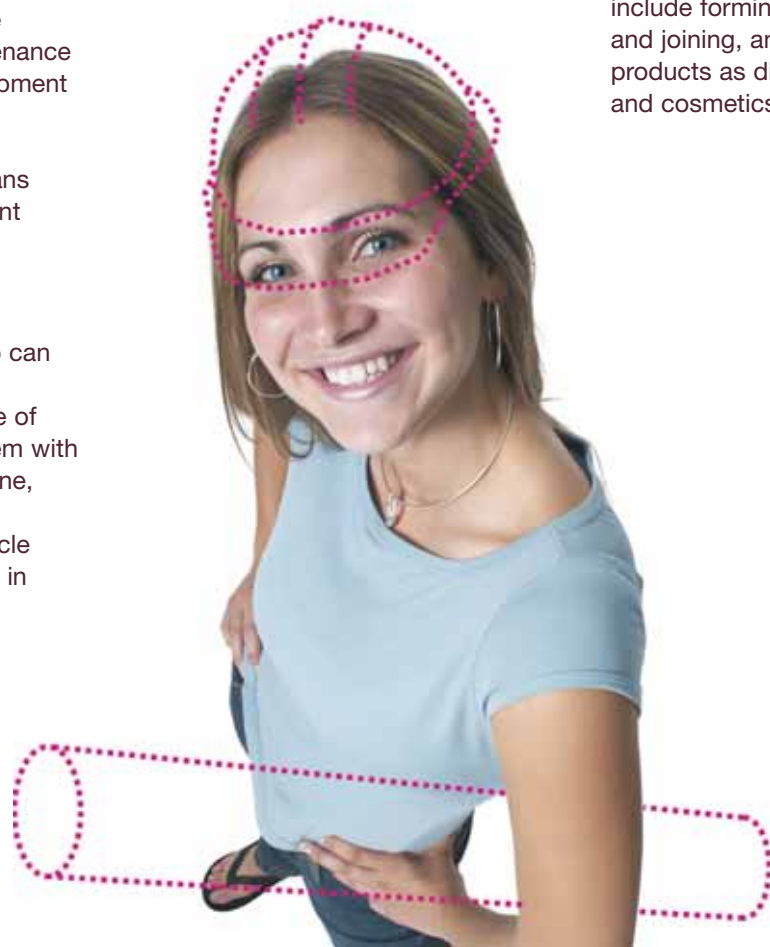
## Food and Drink

### Bakery

Apprentices learn how to maintain a safe and hygienic environment and learn about production control, product efficiency and quality, customer service and management.

### Meat and Poultry Processing

There is a variety of careers available in the meat industry, from meat and poultry plant operations, processing or butchery, to manufacturing, sales or distribution.



## Health and Beauty

### Beauty Therapy

Apprentices learn all aspects of beauty salon treatments as well as how to work in a team and deal with customers.

### Hairdressing

Apprentices help with the running of salons by shampooing, conditioning, drying, cutting and colouring hair. They learn how to deal with customers, so good communication skills are important. Promotion opportunities exist to become a senior stylist or salon manager.



## Health, Care and Public Services

### Early Years Care and Education

Apprentices will learn how to design educational and recreational activities, avoid conflicts, handle difficult situations and understand the unique relationship that childcare workers can have with children in their care.

### Health and Social Care

An apprentice working in health and social care will assist senior care workers and social workers to provide care services.

Health is a large and complex sector of the economy with a wide range of both employers and occupations.

The workforce of two million people can be split into four broad categories: 46 per cent are clinical practitioners and scientists; 30 per cent work in clinical and technical support; 20 per cent in management and administration; and four per cent in estates and maintenance roles.

### Operating Department Practice

Apprentices could help maintain health and safety and prepare patients for operations. They may assist in operations and will be expected to work as part of a highly trained team and on their own.

### Pharmacy Technicians

Apprentices could work as a Dispensing Technician or Hospital Pharmacy Technician in a variety of areas, including hospitals, the community or in marketing/sales. Apprentices need an interest in science and to be friendly, sympathetic and approachable when dealing with the public.

### Security Sector

As a security technician you could install security and emergency systems, advise customers on the most appropriate systems and maintain those systems.

## Hospitality

### Events

The events industry is very varied and apprentices could work in the areas of event organising, venue providing, exhibiting or temporary structures.

### Hospitality

Apprentices can choose from various routes in all aspects of food preparation and cooking, restaurant supervision, housekeeping skills or bar service.

This sector covers hotels, restaurants, pubs, bars and nightclubs, contract food service providers, membership clubs, events, gambling, travel services, tourist services, visitor attractions, youth hostels, holiday parks, self-catering accommodation and hospitality services.



## Manufacturing

### Ceramics

Apprentices working in this field may be involved in manufacturing and decorating ceramic products, processing the raw materials or firing finished items.

### Chemical, Pharmaceutical, Petrochemical Manufacturing and Refining Industries

Apprentices will develop technical skills and a range of interpersonal and supervisory skills. Once qualified, you can specialise in chemical and pharmaceutical process operations, engineering maintenance or laboratory operations.

### Fibreboard Packaging

Apprentices could focus on many areas, including structural design of fibreboard products, graphic design, sales and/or marketing. Management opportunities exist and apprentices could choose to take a related degree, such as Paper Science.

### Food and Drink Manufacturing

Apprentices gain a broad understanding of manufacturing operations as well as of the importance of basic hygiene. The Apprenticeship could lead to management opportunities.

This sector is fiercely competitive and is heavily influenced by the

power of the supermarkets. The demands of consumers are changing. New lifestyles are changing the types of food and drink products customers want to buy.

There has been an increase in niche products, such as ethnic foods, organic produce, wheat free goods, low fat products and healthy living goods.

### Furniture Manufacture

A variety of careers are available in the furniture industry, from producing handcrafted or assembled furniture to constructing upholstered furniture and wood machining.

## Recreation and Travel

### Active Leisure and Learning

Apprentices need to be physically fit and interested in sports and dealing with the public. You'll learn the skills you need to work in jobs such as coach, group leader, assistant manager or administrator.

This sector makes a big contribution to health, education, social inclusion, regeneration, combating crime, personal and social development, neighbourhood renewal and childcare.

### Travel Services

Apprentices could work as a leisure travel consultant, business travel consultant or resort representative. The Apprenticeship is widely used by leisure travel employers and is a main entry route to the industry for young people.

## Transportation

### Driving Goods Vehicles

As a vital link in the nation's supply chain, apprentices will be responsible for the collecting, loading and delivering of goods. Apprentices will be required to drive different sorts of vehicles, from small delivery vans to large goods vehicles (depending on the licence you hold).

### Motor Industry (Vehicle Body Repair and Paint Operations)

Apprentices learn motor vehicle service and repair skills for jobs in a variety of areas, from garages and depots to organisations with fleets of vehicles.

The motor industry sector is very important when it comes to the economy because it counts for a major part of the money generated by the UK.

An estimated 69,000 businesses provide motor industry services as their main business, many of which are small businesses playing an important role in their local economy and community. An estimated 84 per cent of these businesses have less than ten employees.

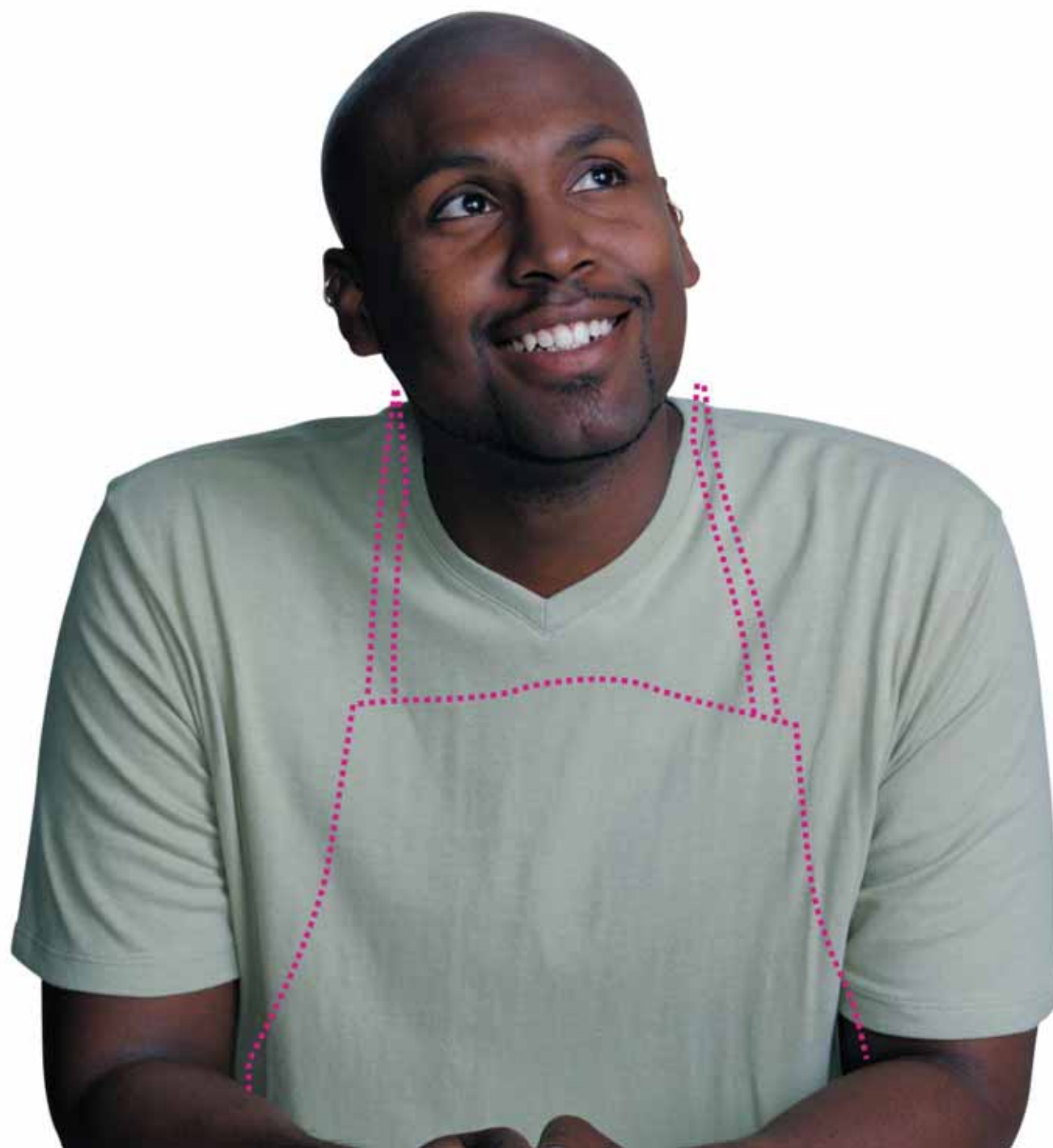
### Rail Transport Engineering

Anyone working in rail engineering could be working in telecommunications, plant, electrification, signalling, track or traction and rolling stock engineering.

### Traffic Office

Apprentices may specialise in transporting goods by road, organising road transport operations, or distribution and warehousing operations.

Freight logistics is all about the journey of products like food items from the initial producer of the ingredients, the movement of the ingredients to processing, manufacture and then retail stores for the customer to then buy. The management of this process is called supply chain management.

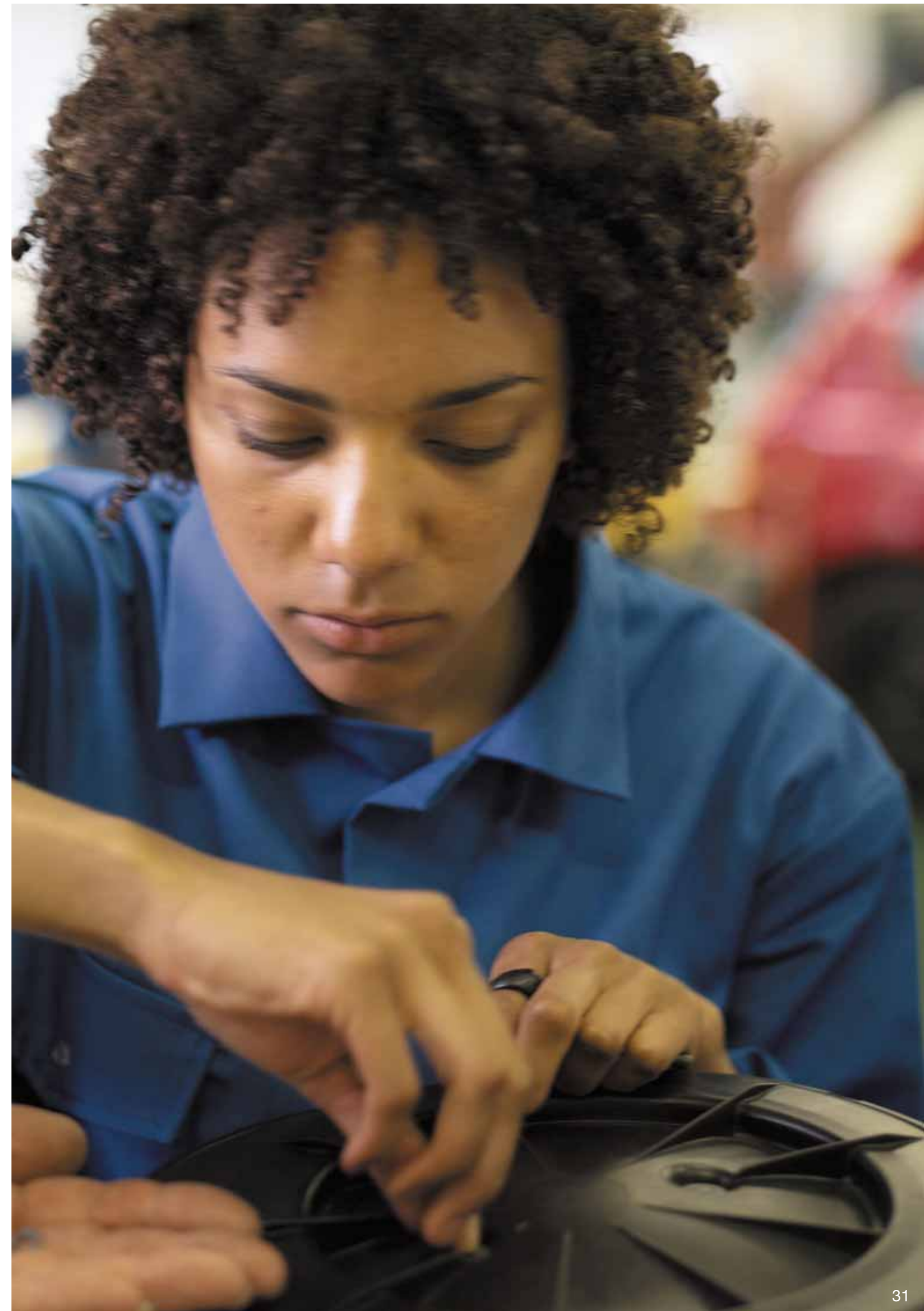

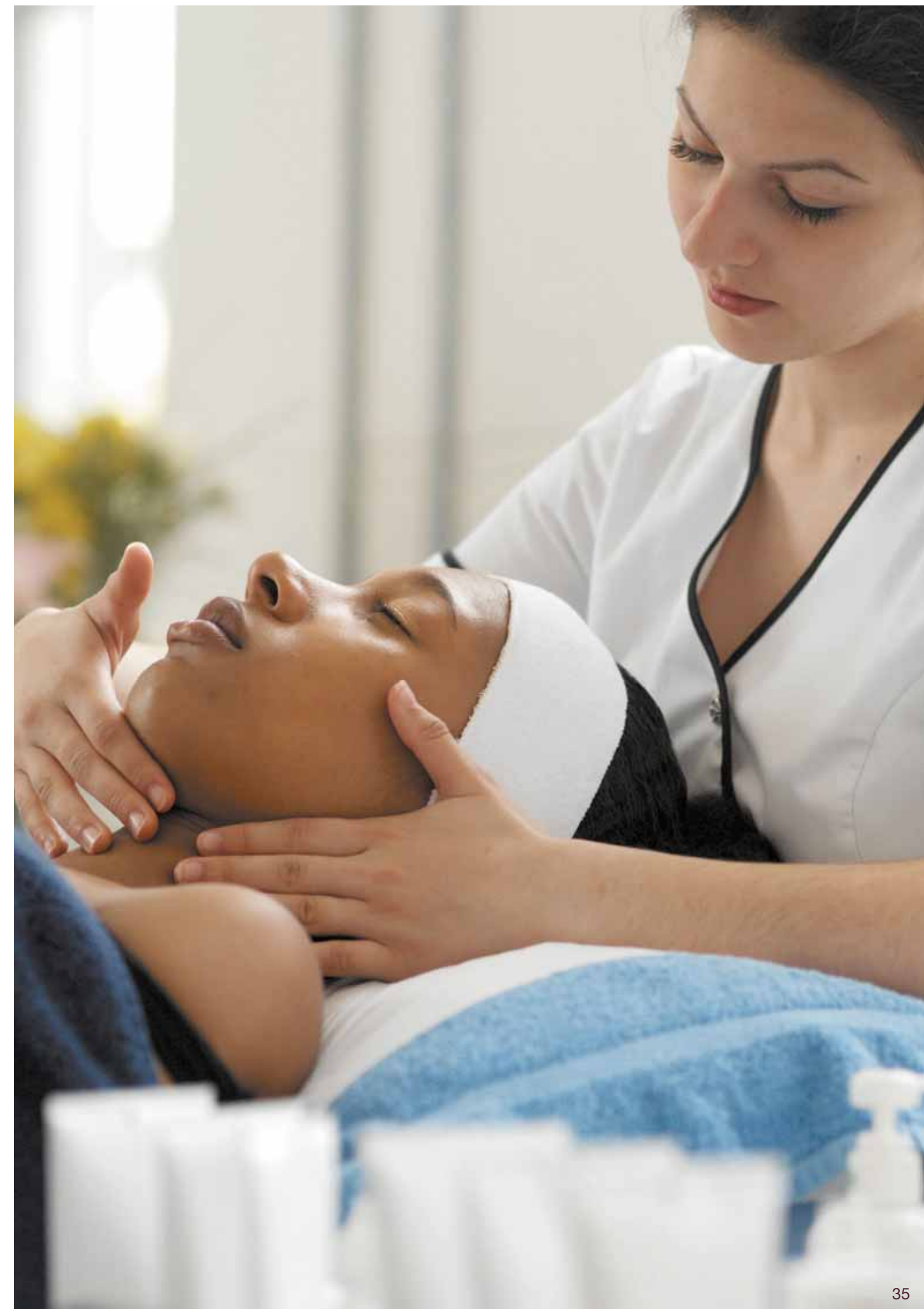
