Our autumn activities

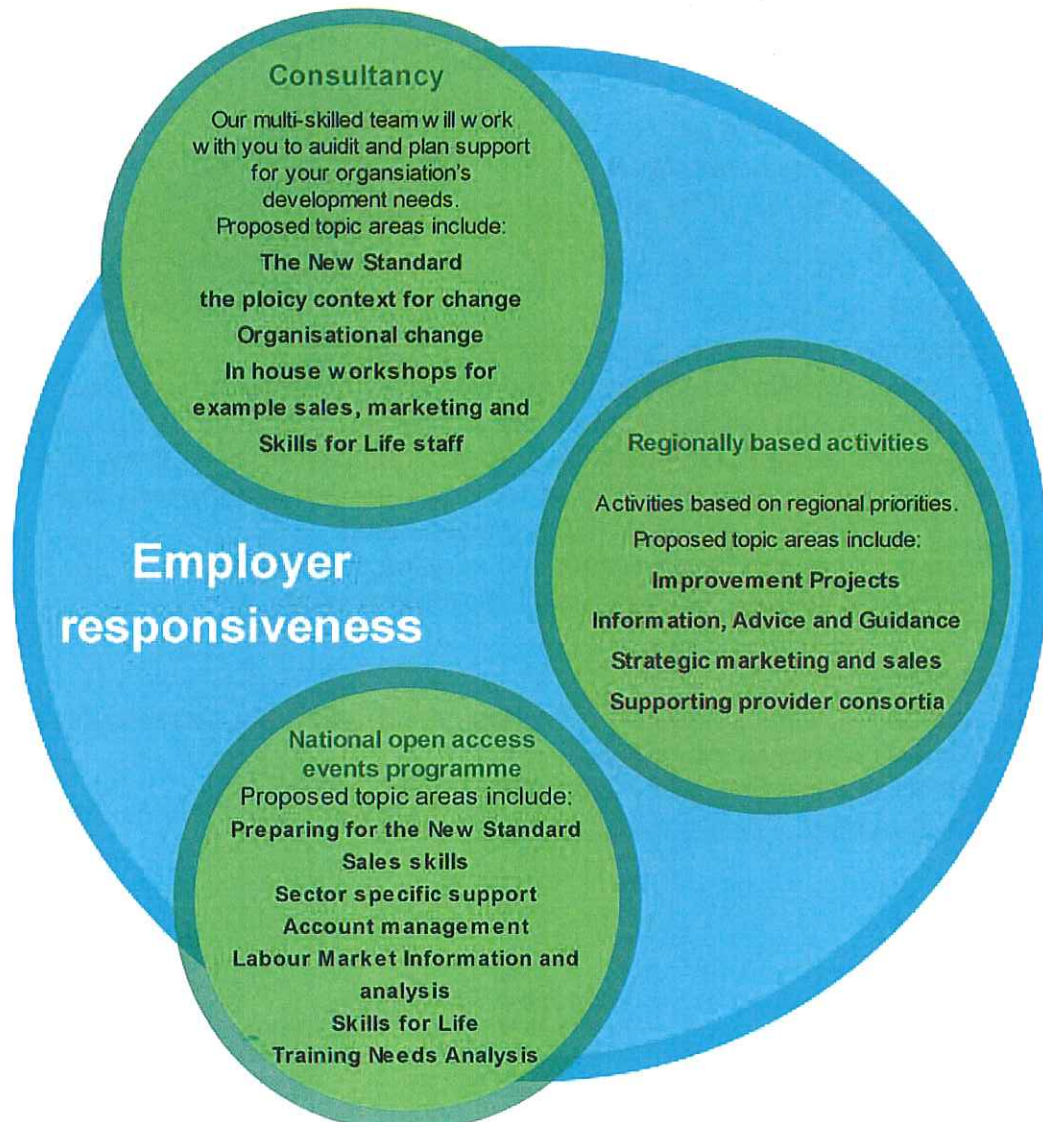
