The Progression Pathways Programme is an LSC ESF Co-financed training programme to ensure that there is suitable employment focused training provision available for those Merseyside resident young people who are not yet ready to enter mainstream programmes

Oakmere Community College now seeks sub-contractors operating on a call-off contract basis to deliver a programme that delivers preparatory training activity to those young people, resident in Greater Merseyside, who: have left compulsory education; are aged 16-19; have yet to achieve a first Level 2 or equivalent and who may require support at Level 1; are vocationally unaware/ undecided and may possess a Level 2 qualification; are not undertaking any other form of education and training or have disengaged from other learning and; are not employed. Projects must complete all of their activity by 31st December 2010.
