

The Learning and Skills Improvement Service (LSIS) is offering all post-16 providers and networks the opportunity to request free in-house briefings to help you get started with the implementation of Progression Pathways within the FLT.

Foundation Learning Tier: Getting started with the delivery of Progression Pathways

What is the offer?

Post-16 providers and provider groups or networks who are not currently delivering Progression Pathways can request a free in-house briefing session to help their organisations prepare for the implementation of Progression Pathways.

The briefing will:

- include an overview of the FLT programme of work and the four Progression Pathways
- share key messages from providers involved in developmental delivery of Progression Pathways in 2008/09.
- develop your understanding of key documents and resources to support the implementation of Progression Pathways
- help you to identify the next steps to implementing Progression Pathways.

Where do the briefings take place?

The briefing sessions will be delivered within your own organisation or at a nominated provider if part of a provider group or network.

Who should attend?

The briefing session will be of most interest to staff with responsibility for preparing for the introduction of Progression Pathways from autumn 2009 and beyond, and for staff likely to be involved in the delivery of Progression Pathways.

It is expected that a minimum of 15 people will attend each briefing and that the event will be supported by senior managers within organisations. We encourage individual providers to invite partner Progression Pathway organisations to the briefing sessions.

These briefings are not designed for LSC phased implementation / developmental delivery post-16 providers or pre-16 test and trial providers who have access to other activities within the FLT Support Programme.

How long will the briefing sessions last?

The final programme will be agreed with the allocated LSN consultant prior to the event. The briefing session will last approximately 2 hours.

How much will the briefing session cost?

The briefing sessions are delivered free of charge. However, there is an expectation that the host provider will provide the venue and refreshments for the briefing and reproduce any FLT Support Programme materials sent through prior to the event.
