The provision set out in the schedule will ensure that those adults (aged 18 and over) under notice of redundancy, those made recently redundant and those that are unemployed will, with high quality education and training support, be ready to continue in, enter or re-enter sustainable employment.

Colleges and training providers have developed working links with Jobcentre Plus in order to provide support and skills development activities that are relevant to both identified vacancies and forthcoming sectoral based skills demand in local labour markets. The aim of is to prepare people for employment in local labour markets with the realistic prospect of moving them into sustainable jobs with training, and then continue to support individuals once in the workforce through Train to Gain or Apprenticeships.

This programme is for those who are:

1. Under general notice of redundancy
2. Newly redundant
3. Unemployed and who would be 'job ready' following receipt of training under this programme.

Interventions will be delivered flexibly in relation to time of day and place. Some delivery may be at employer premises, at provider sites or at community locations. Delivery may be during downtime, during the day, late afternoon, evening or weekends to support individual/employer needs. Plans are in place to have short flexible module available which centre around Effective Communication, Working With Others, Leadership and Time Management. Delivery of these units will be more or less the same across the county. Discussions have taken place with partners to ensure that units can be delivered at short notice and that the flexibility required re resources can be accessed in the shortest possible timespan.</p>
