



# Health & Safety (Cont).



- All learning must take place in a safe, healthy and supportive environment.
- All injuries that fall within the HSE RIDDOR regulations must be reported to the LSC, using the LSC Learner Incident Management Process.
- All Learners must receive training on Health and Safety appropriate to their environment.
- CRB checks are to be carried out when required for the protection of Learners.

# Health & Safety (cont).



Leading learning and skills

- Organisations to have an effective Learner Health, Safety and Welfare Management System.
- Organisations to make an informed judgement about the suitability of learning environments.
- Organisations to have access to health and safety competent person(s).
- Organisations to maintain Health and Safety records.
- Organisations to take account of HSE guidance & other sources.
- Organisations to share Good Practices and utilise LSC Safe Learner Blue Print.

# Health & Safety (cont).



Leading learning and skills

- Organisations should ensure that learners understanding / practical capabilities are assessed periodically.
- **Organisations should have recruitment processes that comply with the Law relating to young and vulnerable learners.**
- Organisations, in working with others, will make arrangements to co-ordinate and co-operate.
- **Organisations who sub-contract will ensure the Learner Health, Safety and Welfare clauses are complied with by the sub-contractor.**
