- Friday 6 June – 12:00pm to 7:00pm
- Saturday 7 June – 10:00am to 6:00pm
- Sunday 8 June – 10:00am to 5:00pm

A free return bus service operated by Bristol Community Transport will run from South and East Bristol to take residents to and from the event.

When Cabot Circus opens in September, there will be a huge variety of jobs on offer within the retail, leisure, hospitality and catering industries – from entry level to management positions and many more besides.

It is one of the highest profile mixed-use developments in the UK and will provide over one million sq ft of high quality retail and leisure uses, as well as apartments, offices and public spaces in the heart of the Bristol.
