

Employer Responsive (Train to Gain) Funding Rates for 2010/11

Note to all providers

Due to a very recent change in funding policy for Employer Responsive (Train to Gain) provision, please be advised that the 2010/11 Learning Aims Database (LAD) may in the short term, hold incorrect funding information for Employer Responsive provision under the Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF).

The aim of the policy change, agreed with the Association of Learning Providers and the Association of Colleges, is to minimise disruption in the sector whilst a wider review of funding methodology gets underway.

As a result, funding rates will revert to being set depending on the level of the Learning Aim. As in the past, there will be a minority of Learning Aims that are agreed exceptions to this general policy.

For the QCF Learning Aims published on the LAD during 2009/10, rates are being reviewed separately and may result in different rates to those quoted above. Information on this will be provided as soon as possible.
