Salary: From £11-20k per year

Duties you may be required to do:

- Maintain a safe, hygienic and secure working environment
- Maintain Customer Care
- Give customers a positive impression of yourself and your organisation
- Contribute to effective teamwork
- Prepare and clear the bar area
- Receive, store and issue drink stock
- Prepare and clear areas for table service
- Prepare and serve spirits and liqueurs
- Prepare and serve cocktails
- Prepare and serve wines
- Serve alcoholic and soft drinks
- Maintain cellars and kegs
- Maintain and deal with payments
- Clean drink dispense lines
- Provide a table/tray service

Skills you need for the job:

- Literacy
- Numeracy
- Communication (informing others, listening to instructions, passing on messages)
- Customer service skills
- Works effectively under pressure
- Preparation of food and drink areas
- Handling financial transactions
- Effective team member (keeps others informed, reports issues, deals with disagreements constructively etc)

- High standard of personal presentation, punctuality and initiative.
- Polite and helpful
- Responsive and enthusiastic
- Positive approach to dealing with people.
- Able to work effectively alone and as a part of a team
